Minutes February 3, 2018

Minutes of the November 4, 2017 and December 2, 2017 meetings were read. Leslie Rose noted corrections. With no further corrections, Neil Crouse requested a motion to approve. Fred Lindlaw so motioned, seconded by June Menkens. Approval carried.

<u>Scholarship</u> – Applications have been delivered to Burke, Cornwall, and Monroe-Woodbury High Schools and notice has appeared in the Photo News.
